

Relocation Approved by City Council: University Lutheran Church received final approval for its much-anticipated relocation to the heart of Purdue’s campus, directly across from the Purdue Engineering Mall. On Monday, February 6 the West Lafayette City Council granted the rezoning necessary for ULu to move into the former Exponent building at 460 Northwestern Avenue. The city council’s vote marks the final step in the initial approval process, clearing the way for #ULuOnTheMove to progress according to schedule. Please continue to pray for a smooth transition to the new building.


